250 Wynwood, the first mixed-use condominium project in Miami's Wynwood Arts District, is offering two new Class A retail spaces as retail condominiums. Wynwood is South Florida's hottest retail destination, home to cutting-edge brands like Ducati, Warby Parker, Aēsop, Parmigiani Fluerier and Ralph Pucci. 





# SITE PLAN









### RETAIL 2
